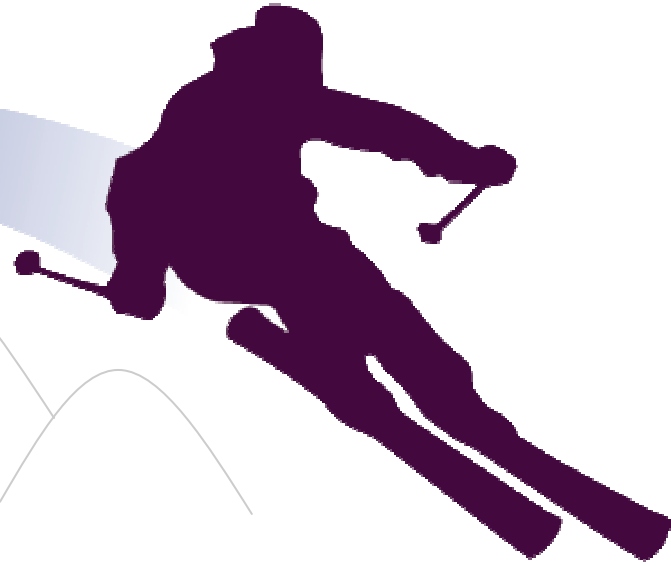

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by President, Jim Kovach, at 7:00 p.m. Thirty-six (36) individuals were in attendance. Jim welcomed everyone to the meeting which was held a week late due to a conflict with E.B.'s on the 3rd Tuesday (St. Pat's Day).

Reports:

President's Report: Jim noted that we were in the 33rd year of the club and gave a historical accounting of meeting sights, trips, parties and officers through the years. He stated that this is the 13th year at our current location and also that the club used to do a lot for the Canton Newsboys and we might go back to our roots, helping that cause to provide winter wear to those in need. Jim also reported on the Membership Report for Alice Nowell. The list is being condensed and may be put on the website and would be password protected if so.

Treasurer's Report: Donna Brancifort reported on the treasury balance. Anyone wishing to see the report and checking account balance can contact Donna as we don't put it in the newsletter to be put out on the internet. Donna noted that we used \$2,684.50 of Blossom money this year and 111 people took advantage of the various trip certificates and coupons. Going into the third year of the Blossom fundraising effort, more thought will be given into how this money will be used. We had one canceled trip and we can carry that bus deposit over to next season so no money has been lost.

Social Report: Donna reported for Diane Marzec that there will be a Euchre night on April 18 at the Brancifort's. There are still 8 openings. The cost is \$3pp for the pot; bring a dish to share and your own beverages. You are welcome to come socialize if you miss out on a spot or don't want to play. Wednesday, April 29 at 6 pm there will be a gathering at The Barrel Room.

Trip Committee Report: Art Pokopac reported 89 people out of 203 responded on the recent survey he sent out via Survey Monkey. The top West votes went to Breckenridge, Lake Tahoe and Crested Butte but other resorts were not far off the vote. The top East votes were Sugarloaf, Stowe, Sunday River and Mt. Tremblant. There will be another survey sent out to address one and two day trips. Art explained what helps influence the trip committee choices and that they look for the best value for the club members. He also stated that CMSC will likely be running the following trips next season: Whistler, Banff, Park City, Telluride and Alyeska. Japan is being looked at for 2017. Art called for the last three trip reports of this season:

Holimont, NY February 19. Jeri Johnson reported because of the frigid temperatures, trip attendee numbers fluctuated quite a bit the days before the trip and she ended up taking 34 people. The conditions ended up being great and they had a wonderful time.

Okemo/Mt. Snow, VT February 22-27. Jim Kovach reported that initial transportation problems caused the group to get checked into the hotel late but the Brancifort's arranged for a pizza/beer party in the lobby. So a big thank you goes out to Donna and Al. Okemo was cold but had well groomed slopes. Mt. Snow was not as groomed but was still enjoyable.

Holiday Valley, March 14 Justin Ford reported that due to the predicted rain, the trip was canceled.

New Business

Elections: Officer nominations were taken and will also be accepted prior to elections at the April meeting. Current officers, excluding Candice Ford, Vice President, are willing to stay in their positions. Donna Brancifort stated if someone is interested in being Treasurer but is unsure about the job duties she would be willing to train an "understudy". If you have a desire for any office you may put your name in at the April meeting but we do need a candidate for Vice President. Lisa Martin nominated Jason Stephan for President and he accepted.

Blossom Concert Series: Jason Stephan reported that Stark County Ski Club has been invited back to Blossom for the 2015 season. A different company is in place of Aramark so there are still unknown details that will be forthcoming as well as training dates for anyone who has not had any previous training. You do not need to be a club member to participate. Jason read through a list of concerts that are currently on the schedule.

Biking: Bill Bail reported that as soon as the weather breaks, the Tuesday bike rides will begin. There will also be some Saturday dates. Contact Bill if you would like to be on the email list to know where each Tuesday's ride/restaurant will take place.

Misc.: In lieu of a spring party, a summer wine tasting party at the Kovach's will be planned. Details will come later. There may be a chili cook-off contest at the Kick off the Season Party in the fall so dust off your chili recipes and start planning.

Meeting Adjournment

Meeting was adjourned at 7:55 p.m. Art Pokopac motioned to adjourn and Fred Scherer seconded. Jim Shear won the 50/50 raffle.

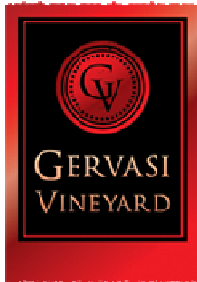
