View From The Top By: Jason Stephan

The first meeting of the year is in the rearview mirror, and the last days of summer are upon us. It won't be long until we are watching the skies and hoping for the first snow flakes of winter to fall. Are you geared up and ready for another great season? If not, don't miss your chances. A staple of our October social calendar for the past few years has been Tolerton's Ski Shack with open house this year October 20-21st, and BMBW open house and ski swap October 12-14th. Both are two great places to get the gear essentials for another great season. At our first meeting of the year we discussed two constitutional amendments addressing the hard work of Bill Bail (Website), and Donna Brancifort (Fundraising). Bill has already done a mountain amount of work getting us into the 21st century. Donna's fundraising efforts are already on track to break last year's record haul. We want to add the Position of fundraising chair as a permanent position and increase the amount of compensation for webmaster. We now have two trips already sold out. The Sunday River trip is SOLD OUT, and for the first time that I can remember we have a sellout of a bus trip before the first meeting was called to order. The Holiday Valley & Holimont trip is also SOLD OUT. Anyone wishing to join us for the two days of skiing and socializing in Ellicottville, NY will have to self-drive and hope for open rooms at the Wingate. Constitution proposed changes

Under Section G: Compensation/Trip Discount Vouchers

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by President Jason Stephan at 7:00 p.m. Jason thanked everyone for coming to the first meeting of the season and asked new members and first time attendees to introduce themselves. Sixty-two (62) individuals were in attendance. Jason called for the following reports:

Officer / Chair Reports

President Report: Jason Stephan reported that he and Gail had met with Compass Media and as a result, the Club has a nice article in their publication. This publication was handed out for members to see and Jason said these are placed in dentist and doctor offices as well as grocery stores and can also be seen online. The article highlights that we are an all season club with socials and philanthropy opportunities. Jason stated that trip vouchers will be accepted for any club sponsored trip, not just ski trips. Jason reported that membership and trip applications are online. This year we will accept paper applications but hope to be all electronic next year. He also said that this year we are accepting credit card payments for Membership Dues only, as a way to "test the waters" but hope to add trip payments next year. Certificates were passed out for Officers, Committees and Chairpersons after the meeting.

Vice President Report: Jeri Johnson reported that the Kick off the Season party will be held November 25th at The Barrel Room from 5-10pm. The Club will provide chicken and pizza and members are asked to bring a side, appetizer or dessert. More info will be coming.

Treasurer Report: Melba Gasque reported on the amount currently in the club treasury. Melba stated credit card surcharges would be waived at the meeting and that she processed 3 membership transactions.

Secretary Report: Jennifer Stephan reported she had \$195 in the 50/50 raffle and would sell tickets after the meeting. Jennifer reminded everyone that half the pot goes to the winning raffle ticket and the other half goes to charity.

Facebook Report: Gary Johnson reported that 300 people saw the winery trip post and reminded everyone to find and like our page to get reminders of meetings and socials. Also, there will be a Facebook contest for a chance to win a (1) day trip for two. Follow the page and share posts to be entered. The drawing will have a live feed on FB at the December 18 meeting.

Biking/Website Report: Bill Bail reported despite a lot of rain on Tuesdays they managed to get a few bike rides in. He reported 16 are going this weekend to Titusville to stay overnight at the Caboose Motel and bike the trail in Oil State Park. Bill also reported that all forms are online on our website and there are links to our Facebook page from the Home Page. He is still working on credit card payments because of surcharges and how to handle refunds if a trip is cancelled.

Merchandise: Mary Ann Pellegrino was not there to report but there should be merchandise available to purchase at the next meeting.

Marketing: Gail Vogt was not there to report. Jason reported the Boston Mills Open House is October 12-14 and volunteers are needed to man the club table. Club members are invited Thursday, October 11th to the preview night at Boston Mills which gives you first chance at swap items before the Open House. A group of volunteers helped pass out water for a recent towpath ride and our club has been recognized as a "go to" group for these events. Gail and Bill are still looking at which portion of the towpath the club should "adopt" for good club exposure. There will be no Sept. CMSC meeting but Gail is planning to attend the October meeting. There will be an initial edition of The Sitzmark and the club has submitted articles. Due to lack of advertising, that may be the only edition.

Membership: Roberta Graham reported there have been 10 new members in the past few months and currently we have 244 members. Please remember membership dues should be paid by October 31 and forms can be completed online.

Newsletter Report: Mike Bishop reported he would like trip leaders to get him updated trip numbers to publish and also have your newsletter info to him before this coming Sunday, the 23rd as he is going out of town and after that, newsletter assembly will be up to Bill Bail.

Social Chair Report: Vickie Roe reported she has two upcoming socials. On October 6, Roberta Graham will be leading a bus tour to 3 wineries and 1 brewery. Currently there are 5 people signed up at a cost of \$30 per person plus drinks/food. The Ski Shack Open House is the weekend of October 20th. RSVP to Vickie to be included in the dinner count at Don Pancho's after the open house. They are working on a date with Quaker Steak and Lube for Winter Fest which will possibly be December 1.

Trip Committee Report: Scott Hunsinger reported that 2 trips are already sold out. He called for the following trip reports:

Sunday River, ME Jan 27-Feb 1 \$925 Trip Leader John Masalko. SOLD OUT

Seven Springs, PA Feb 8 \$75 Trip Leaders Jeri & Gary Johnson. Jeri reported she has 12 signed up. There will be no northern pickup and the bus will load at Faircrest starting 5:40 AM for a 6 AM departure. Please plan for your dinner at the resort before the bus departs there at 7 PM.

Peek n Peak/Holiday Valley, Feb 23-24 \$192 Trip Leader Roberta Graham. Roberta reported that Peek n Peak will be the 1st stop with one night stay at the Comfort Inn in Jamestown. Holiday Valley will be the 2nd day of skiing.

Panorama, BC Mar 2-9 \$1,380 Trip Leader Art Pokopac. Art reported that there are multiple pricing options for this trip. Panorama is a great resort with wide runs and beautiful scenery so what are you waiting for?

New Business

Constitutional Amendments: Jason Stephan reported that our website is creating a large, ongoing workload for Bill Bail and moved for a constitutional change that the amount of a \$250 credit be provided to the webmaster to be used for club activities or merchandise. Mark Fetzer seconded the motion. Jason went on to state that having been involved with Blossom and knowing the work involved in coordinating volunteers for fundraising, he believes it is necessary to create a Fundraising Chair position with compensation. Jason moved that the position of Fundraising Chair be appointed and that a credit be provided for 5% of the amount raised, not to exceed \$250, to the fundraising chair to be used for club activities or merchandise. Jeri Johnson seconded the motion. These two amendment changes will be published in October's newsletter and voted on at the October meeting.

Fundraising: Donna Brancifort handed out \$7,700 in trip discount vouchers to workers. She stated that over \$7,000 has been collected but there are still some large checks expected. She will be posting upcoming events and could use more help this weekend. Donna stated that volunteer workers have made the early sign up discounts possible and several factors may play into changes being made to the program next year such as requiring you work an event to use. For this season, everyone can still use the early sign up discounts.

SnowTrails: Mike Lockhart presented season pass information for Snowtrails in Mansfield. The one day a week pass is \$200 and a Season Pass is \$270. There are price breaks if you purchase before October 13th and November 15th. Any questions, contact John Masalko at johnmasalko@sbcglobal.net.

Miscellaneous: The Ski Shack Open House will be October 21-22. Buckeye Sports will hold the Cleveland Ski Fest September 21-23.





Online Purchasing Procedure: Individual Participants

- Click the "Seasonal Clubs" Banner located on the right side of the page. Make sure that you read the content then click the "Buy Now with your promo code" link
- Select "Seasonal Clubs" from the "Choose a Category" column
- Click on the desired attribute (Season Freedom or Super Flex) from the middle column, "Choose an Attribute", and then select the pass you want from the 3rd column, "Choose a Product" and add to cart (a description for each choice is shown below).
- To select an add-on, click "Group add-ons" from the category column then select the products that you want from the middle column. Note: All add-ons must be done at this time. The system will not let you add them unless they are done on the same transaction.
- "Add to Cart" (your cart will be located at the bottom of the page) and click the "next" button.
- From the "Please Select" drop down find your **group code** (example: W33-Bishop Hartley). They are in order by the 1st letter.
- Click the "assign" button.
- If you are a returning pass holder, search your name as you will be in the database.
- Review information for accuracy (not all information will be displayed for security reasons unless you created and remember your username and password). If you are new to Snow Trails select "add new guest" and fill out the required fields shown, click "next".
- Check to make sure the product selected is correct as well as the name and club code and click "next".
- Enter your **Promotion Code**, which you should receive from your club leader, in the box provided and click "submit". This will reduce the price to the current rate.
