1st Lt. Ashley White-Stumpf was killed during combat operations in Kandahar Province, Afghanistan on October 22, 2011 when the assault force she was supporting triggered an improvised explosive device. Ashley was assigned to the 230th Brigade Support Battalion, 30th Heavy Brigade Combat Team, North Carolina National Guard, Goldsboro, NC and served as a member of a Cultural Support Team attached to a Joint Special Operations Task Force in Afghanistan.

Ashley grew up in Marlboro, OH and attended Marlinton High School. 75% of proceeds will go towards a scholarship fund at Marlinton and 25% will go towards Hero Dogs. Donations can also be given by going to this link [fundraiser page](#), donations can also be made through the registration process.

Our summer biking group meets on Tuesday evenings May through August and we ride a section on the Ohio Erie Towpath between Akron and Navarre weather permitting. You ride at your own pace and go as far as you are comfortable with. Our rule of thumb is we ride out for 45 minutes, take a short break then return making the ride about an hour and a half long as a guideline. I send out an email a day or two ahead of time to let you know where we will be meeting at to start. We also try to include a Saturday ride each month. The Saturday rides will include other nearby trails and may coincide with other activities in the area.

The rides will be on Tuesday evening starting at 6 PM weather permitting. The minimum temperature requirement is 60 degrees and of course, not raining. You do not need to be Stark County Ski Club member to ride with us. You do not even need to be a rider as you are welcome to join us and just take a walk on the trail.

When I advertised for bids for the upcoming ski season's bus trips I was a little leery about what we were going to get. As most of you know The State Of Ohio raised the gasoline tax by 10.5 cents per gallon but they raised the tax on diesel fuel by 19 cents per gallon. I figured prices would take a big jump. Surprisingly the carrier that we used last season did what I consider to be an excellent job in minimizing their increases for 2020. The resorts have raised lift tickets only slightly so I think we are going to be in good shape when we set prices on the bus trips. We don't expect to see bus trip prices go up very much and in some cases not at all.

CABO 50% or better full
OKEMO 72% full
LAKE TAHOE 75% full

Spots are filling fast

Now a review about the Epic Pass. Since Okemo and Lake Tahoe are both Epic Pass resorts and both trips are booked with ski.com, if you buy your Epic Pass through ski.com you will get an additional \$50 off the cost of your trip. That's \$50 off one or the other, not both. It is still a good deal. People that are thinking about taking additional trips on their own either east or west to participating Epic Pass resorts should definitely look into this offer. There is a link in the trip flyers to purchase your Epic Pass through ski.com. You can also purchase an Ikon Pass through ski.com if you want.

If you are active military or have past military service you may be entitled to additional discounts on your Epic or Ikon Pass and should contact them directly. Ski.com cannot offer those discounts.

Trip Agreement & Application

Please read and in designated question on the application, answer that you have read this document. The undersigned participant applies to participate in the Stark County Ski Club (SCSC) trip described below, subject to the following conditions:

1. PAYMENTS:

Trip deposits will vary per trip and must be paid and submitted along with this signed "Trip Agreement and Application" (below). Balance shall be due & payable in accordance with payment schedules established by SCSC & described in the trip description in "Tips & Tails", the club newsletter, or on the club website www.starkcountyskiclub.org. Charges may be added for supplemental costs such as fuel surcharges, taxes, single supplement for room and airport departure changes to the price of the trip. All payment checks shall be payable to "Stark County Ski Club" & sent to trip leader noted.

2. WITHDRAWAL & CHANGE:

Stark County Ski Club (SCSC) may withdraw any trip from its schedule at any time; may refuse to accept or refrain any person as a participant at any time for any reason; and may change the itinerary at any time.

3. RESPONSIBILITY:

Stark County Ski Club & TimkenSteel are acting gratuitously for the applicant and shall not be responsible or liable for any loss of or damage to any baggage, property, or for any loss, injury, death, accident, delay, inconvenience or any other loss occurring during or occasioned by an applicant's participation in any trip, and as a result of any actual or alleged negligence of SCSC or any SCSC member or officer.

4. IDENTIFICATION:

Participants are responsible for any required identification for travel. This may include, but not limited to, an up to date and valid passport, visa, drivers license or proof of identification and citizenship.

5. MINORS:

Any minor's participant's "Trip Application & Agreement" must be co-signed by his/her parent or legal guardian. The minor must be accompanied on the trip by a parent or legal guardian or their designee who shall be wholly and fully responsible for said minor's conduct and well being.

6. CANCELLATION & REFUNDS:

- A). Cancellation by participant means & includes: failure to abide by terms of this agreement, notice of intent to cancel; failure to make timely payments; failure for any reason to meet the departure or return of the trip.
- B). When SCSC cancels or withdraws a trip, the participant shall be entitled to a full refund unless such cancellation or withdrawal is necessitated or caused, in whole or part, by participant's cancellation or failure to make timely payments.
- C). Where participant cancels more than 30 days before departure of a 1-day or multi-day trip or more than 60 days before the departure of a longer trip, then participant shall be responsible for a cancellation service charge of not less than \$10.00 & any fees charged by an airline if seats have already been ticketed.
- D). Where participant cancels less than 30 days before the departure of a 1-day or multi-day trip or less than 60 days before the departure of a longer trip and where the trip departs full or where participant provides an immediate replacement who completes this agreement, then participant shall receive a full refund less the cancellation service charge & any fees accessed because of the name change. If the trip departs unfilled and the participant has not provided a replacement, then the participant may be entitled to a partial refund less any amounts pre-paid by SCSC for participant's unused transportation, lodging, meals, lifts or amenities and less the cancellation service charge. If the applicant cancels and the trip departs unfilled, the applicant will be refunded the amount of any un-purchased lift tickets. Transportation, lodging and other special costs may NOT be refunded. Specific trip circumstances will determine if any refund of these costs are possible. In any case, the participant is responsible to SCSC for any amounts paid out by SCSC over and above payments made by participant. Any pre-paid expenses that are not refunded to the club by the airlines, resorts, etc. are not subject to be refunded to participant.
