If you have any questions please contact the trip leader or any SCSC officer. At this time that we are **NOT** going to activate the local trip online payment system. There are a number of things to work out for the process and one of them is the use of vouchers.

The response to the new online membership payment system appears to be appealing to many of the members. For those members who have not renewed their membership yet please try this convenient system. We think it is quick, easy to use, and the small service fee allows us to operate it. For all of those who still prefer any of the other two ways to renew your membership; if you have not filed as you read this you are now overdue. 
