I would like to congratulate this year's Trip Committee members; **Scott Hunsinger, Drew Gonyias, Roberta Graham, and Art Pokopac**. I would like to also thank Janet Brunecz for her previous service to the trip committee and Jim Kovach for accepting to run for a position.

Starting June 1st the SCSC will no longer snail mail the newsletter out to anyone. We currently produce multiply documents which are sent to the editor, who then assembles them into the current newsletter, which is then converted to a pdf to be emailed out to the membership. In the past those who have paid an additional fee (both of them) got the newsletter printed off and snail-mailed out. The month of May will be the final USPS mailing of the SCSC newsletter. To become more eco-friendly, we are heading towards a total web base digital format. During this transition, we will still produce a pdf formatted newsletter to email out monthly. My goal is to have everything on the website by the end of May 2022. **WHY Mike** would we go to all the work of placing all of the SCSC information into one location, accessible 24/7, updatable at a moment's notice, and viewable from your personal leash (aka cell phone)? Because my woodshop really, really, really, misses me.

As the SCSC plans next season, we are already feeling the side effects of the 2020 ski season. The airlines now require a non-refundable deposit on booking group air. Vail resorts are requiring a non-refundable deposit on lodging reservations. Although these deposits do get applied to the total cost of the trip, they are still non-refundable. In a concerted effort to protect the SCSC, we will be passing these new deposit requirements onto all of the participants of the Mt. Snow & Park City trips that we now have under contract.

Over the past month, I have been fielding several of Epic Pass questions. Do I need to purchase an Epic Pass, which one should I buy, what website should I go through to purchase a pass? All good questions crawling out of a pandemic year and aching to plan ahead. No, you do not have to buy an Epic Pass. All of the trips will offer lift tickets. Shelby & I typically buy the Epic Local Pass. We have found it to be enough ski resort locations to fill our season no matter what direction we travel. The Local pass is also good for all Epic Ohio ski resorts with unlimited access. Now take a look at John Masalko's article for where and why to buy the Epic Pass... this year.

Note: The Cuyahoga River Glow Paddle has been canceled and Jason is hoping to reschedule something local to fill the same date.

Trip Committee Chair John Masalko

The trip committee with the Eboard approval is moving forward with the Mt. Snow Vermont trip. We placed a non-refundable deposit down on the Mt. Snow Vermont trip, which is a Vail resort and works with the Epic Pass. If you order your Epic pass through Ski.com at [Stark-county-sc-passes.event.ski.com](https://stark-county-sc-passes.event.ski.com), you can receive a discount on the land portion of the Mt. Snow package. Full Epic (-\$50.00), Local Epic (-\$40.00), three or more day Epic (-\$25.00), but you have to go to the ski.com link to purchase your Epic Pass. Look for more information on the [save the date page](#) within the Newsletter.

We have a contract with Sports America and waiting on the Air to drop on our Park City trip. This is also a Vail resort, and the Epic pass will work here, but for their discounted land package, you will have to go through [Sportsamerica.com/epic-stark](https://sportsamerica.com/epic-stark) to purchase your Epic Pass to qualify for the land discount off their package.

If you are only planning to go on one big trip with the SCSC, you will have to purchase your pass through that trip's tour provider to receive the appropriate discount.
