Epic Pass News: This season, Vail Resorts will focus on COVID-19 safety protocols in *indoor* spaces.

Mountain Access: They will not have a mountain reservation system this season and will load lifts and gondolas at normal capacity, optimizing guest movement around the resorts.

<u>Face Coverings</u>: **Face coverings will be required in indoor settings**, including in restaurants, lodging properties, restrooms, retail and rental locations, and on buses.

<u>Dining – Reservations</u>: Like last season, **guests will be required to book a reservation to eat at many of our on-mountain restaurants.** 

<u>Dining – Vaccinations:</u> Guests will be required to show proof of COVID-19 vaccinations to dine at our indoor, and on-mountain quick-service (cafeteria-style) restaurants.
