Our Holiday Valley/Holimont Trip is also progressing well as it usually does. Right now, we are looking at Sunday January 8th as our Ski Season Kick Off Party at Snow Trails. This will be in the new warming lodge at the base of the Mt. Mansfield triple lift. Members of all ages as well as potential new members are welcome. Hey there Skiers, Riders, and Paddlers,

So far, it's been a great summer, and even though the temps have been Hot, Hot, Hot... we have managed to have great weather for our paddles. Our last paddle was one of the best turnouts we have had this season with 14 paddlers making their way out to Walborn Reservoir. Summer is not over yet and we still have some wonderful paddles scheduled. Coming up Friday August 12th we, along with Friends of Stark Parks, are putting on a Moonlight Glow paddle. This is a fundraiser to help Stark Parks with the purchase and installation of an ADA accessible Kayak launch. These launch's help folks with disabilities who otherwise would not be able to get

into and out of the Kayak or launch from shore to water. These systems are very expensive, around \$50,000 and Stark Parks has \$25,000 available but like most government money it's use it or lose it, so if they don't spend it this fiscal year, they will not have that available for the next year. So, we need to help make up around \$25,000 to secure the purchase of this dock. For paddlers there is no registration fee for the event, but we are asking for donations for participation. We are holding a basket raffle and the grand prize is a new Pelican Mustang 100X Kayak and Paddle. There are several great prize baskets with an approximate value of \$50.00 and up. These are themed baskets with themes of Skiing, Kayaking and just general outdoor fun themes. I would like to thank the following folks for making these Prizes available, for the Kayak the following families donated the kayak the Bush family, the Kiko Family, and the Masalko family. Prize baskets donated by Gail Vogt, Alyssa Givens, Joyce Tolerton and the Ski Shack in Alliance, Donna and Al Brancifort, The Stephan Family, Shady Rays sunglasses and snow goggles! We will still take donations if you wish to help us out. We have the pavilion reserved for the evening and hope to have a food truck for the event. If you wish to join us, Stark Parks will have a few Kayaks available for rent on a first come first serve basis, and I am looking into a kayak rental facility from Cuyahoga Falls area to provide rentals if needed. Even if you don't plan on Kayaking, please come out to support this great event.

The summer biking group meets on Tuesday evenings starting in May through August, and we ride a section on the Ohio Towpath between Akron and Navarre, weather permitting. You ride at your own pace and go as far as you are comfortable with on that day. Our rule of thumb is we ride out for 45 minutes, take a short break, then return, making the ride about an hour and a half long as a guideline.

The Tuesday evening rides will be starting at 6 PM, weather permitting. The minimum temperature we shoot for is 60 degrees, and of course, not raining. I am giving up on trying to second guess if it is going to rain or not, so I will not send out any ride canceled notifications. Use your best judgement. You do not need to be Stark County Ski Club member to ride with us. You do not even need to be a rider, as you are welcome to join us and just take a walk on the trail.

We are now in high gear for our AVI activities, and it appears we aren't going to slow down any time soon! Besides reading what is going on in this newsletter, there are more details given in the weekly emails when we are requesting volunteers. Please read those emails if you are interested in participating. New volunteers are welcome! We consider this a community activity, that happens to have a benefit! You will receive a Trip Discount Voucher for each event you volunteer for, which you can use to help you pay for your trips with SCSC!

Please wear black or khaki bottoms (slacks, shorts or capris). Wear a solid-colored shirt. Wear comfortable close toed shoes. Unless instructed otherwise, park in Lot A near the Symphony Gate (SW corner of the stadium). Because of construction, you can get to Lot A from Clarendon (off of Fulton) or 17th Street from the West or South. When you arrive at the stadium, check-in at the small brick building, just inside the Symphony Gate. You will sign in, pick up an apron and an AVI hat. After you have worked a couple of events, you will receive a Stark County Ski Club hat to wear! For most events, we will be in what we call "our stand", which is the largest and busiest stand in the stadium! 
