Well, we are about to enter the heart of summertime so I hope everyone is ready to enjoy the nice weather. I love summer but still look forward to winter. Mainly because I look much better in a ski jacket than a Speedo. But I digress.

Somewhere in this newsletter you should find flyers for the club's 3 biggest trips this season. Don't worry, we are still working on a few others. In early January we are planning on having our Ski Season Kickoff Party at Snow Trails. More details to follow. We still have a few things to work out.

The Holiday Valley/Holimont Trip is scheduled for January 11-13 and is priced at \$314, the same as last season. Stratton, Vermont is scheduled for January 29th through February 3rd and is priced at \$1403. Whitefish, Montana is March 7-14 and is priced at \$1369 OR LESS, depending on your age. If you are 70 or older you can do it for \$1159.

One thing that I want to mention is that I recently participated in a Zoom meeting with several trip chairs from other CMSC clubs. Many clubs are doing western trips this season that are priced between \$1800 and \$2000. You read that correctly. Their eastern trips are very pricey also. The reason SCSC was able to come up with some very good prices is that we didn't just lock in on a few resorts or specific dates, we were open to proposals from several resorts and promoters, and we booked early before prices started to go up.

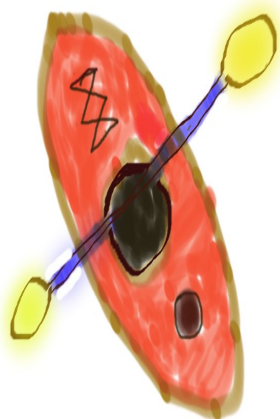

Hey Skiers, Riders and Paddlers,

We have had great weather for all of our paddles this season, if you haven't been out and joined us this year you're really missing out on some great paddling.

Our Saturday Tuscarawas River paddle had conflicted with our Tom Benson HOF schedule, and we postponed the Saturday paddle, and switched up and added Atwood Lake Paddle to our FNF, even though we didn't have a huge turnout we had perfect weather, and very low powerboat traffic on Atwood for a beautiful Friday evening, and managed to pull off, a great 4.5-mile paddle.

Starting off July we have Deer Creek July 1st, Wingfoot July 8th, Walbourne July 22nd. Our scheduled Mohican River Campout and kayaking has run into a bit of a snag. The campground has posted that we can not put in the river at the campsite, due to liability issues. So, we are looking at a put in upriver from the campsite, in downtown

Loudonville or at the kayak/Canoe livery put in so we can stay together as a group. This will have us pulling out at the campsite like we have always done.

If you haven't already blocked off the day, make sure you are able to join us Friday August 12th for our 2nd annual Moonlight Glow paddle fundraiser. This is a fundraiser we are putting on with Friends of Stark Parks for the purchase and installation of an ADA Kayak launch. Accessible kayak launches make kayaking more readily available for folks with disabilities and mobility issues, this opens up kayaking and enjoying to parks to more folks, some who may have thought that this was no longer a possibility.

There is no fee for participation, but we are asking for donations from all paddlers who are participating in the event. Additionally, we are holding a fundraising raffle, we have already secured some great prizes and are getting more. We have some club members and their families who are graciously donating a new Kayak, Shady Rays have donated three pair of high-end sunglasses for the cause, and we are putting together ski, and kayak related items for baskets to be raffled off also. The night of the event we are planning on having food available to purchase and are looking at the possibility of having one or two food trucks to service those needs.

We have the pavilion secured for this event, so you will have space to leave your items/coolers and après paddle outfits and change of clothing. Stark Parks marina will be open late for Kayak and Canoe rental (discount) for those who do not have their own kayak, Canoe, or SUP. Contact Stark Parks Sippo Lake Marina for availability and reservation. If you just want to come out and hang out with us, we would love to see you there and your support for this great community activity.

Bikers

The summer biking group meets on Tuesday evenings starting in May through August, and we ride a section on the Ohio Towpath between Akron and Navarre, weather permitting. You ride at your own pace and go as far as you are comfortable with on that day. Our rule of thumb is we ride out for 45 minutes, take a short break, then return, making the ride about an hour and a half long as a guideline.

The Tuesday evening rides will be starting at 6 PM, weather permitting. The minimum temperature we shoot for is 60 degrees, and of course, not raining. I am giving up on trying to second guess if it is going to rain or not, so I will not send out any ride canceled notifications. Use your best judgement. You do not need to be Stark County Ski Club member to ride with us. You do not even need to be a rider, as you are welcome to join us and just take a walk on the trail.

AVI / Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium News:



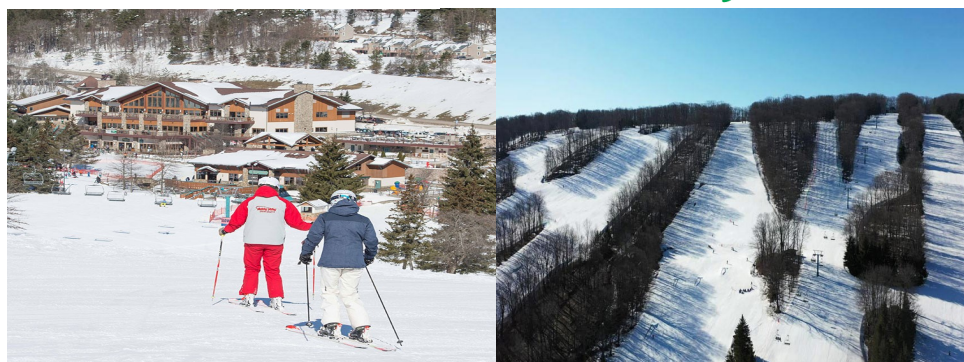
