SCSC Summer Biking Program



Bikers

The summer biking group meets on Tuesday evenings starting in May through August, and we ride a section on the Ohio Towpath between Akron and Navarre, weather permitting. You ride at your own pace and go as far as you are comfortable with on that day. Our rule of thumb is we ride out for 45 minutes, take a short break, then return, making the ride about an hour and a half long as a guideline.

The Tuesday evening rides will be starting at 6 PM, weather permitting. The minimum temperature we shoot for is 60 degrees, and of course, not raining. I am giving up on trying to second guess if it is going to rain or not, so I will not send out any ride canceled notifications. Use your best judgement. You do not need to be Stark County Ski Club member to ride with us. You do not even need to be a rider, as you are welcome to join us and just take a walk on the trail.

AVI / Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium News:



We are getting a lesson in patience from the Hall of Fame Village! AVI John is passing along information to us as he receives it from The Village. I am only sharing the list to keep you informed of the events tentatively planned for Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium. AVI might decide to use another group or its own staff for some of the smaller events. Please hold back from signing up until I provide check in times & how many people AVI wants us to have, although AVI veterans already have an idea for some of the events. I will be sending out emails to recruit volunteers as soon as I have the information from AVI. When the emails are sent, please respond as soon as you can. I will also provide parking information in those emails.

Please wear black or khaki bottoms (slacks, shorts or capris). Wear any solid-colored shirt. Wear comfortable close toed shoes. Consider the weather. A jacket or sweater is ok to wear. When you arrive at the stadium, check-in at the small brick building, just inside the Symphony Gate, on the SW corner of the stadium. You will sign in, pick up an apron and an AVI hat. After you have worked a couple of events, you will receive a Stark County Ski Club hat to wear! For most events, we will be in what we call “our stand”, which is the largest and busiest stand in the stadium! It is officially named Stand 2 and it is on the South side, Level 2, on the 50-yard line. We are AVI’s “go to” group! We have earned a great reputation, as dedicated and conscientious workers and we want to keep it that way! We not only represent Stark County Ski Club, but we also represent Stark County and the Hall of Fame Village, to all of the visitors to the stadium. We work hard, but we also have a good time with each other.

We consider this a community activity, that happens to have a benefit! You will receive a Trip Discount Voucher for each event you volunteer for, which will help you pay for your trips with SCSC!
