Proposed Constitutional Amendments

Current Constitution Language:

Add the trip chair position to the executive committee to replace past president.

Article IV Government

Section B-1 (Members):

The Ex. Comm.is a permanent and standing committee of the Club consisting of the current officers and the previous president.

Article II DEFINITIONS AND CONVENTIONS

Section F: Executive Committee

The "Executive Committee" hereinafter referred to as the "Ex. Comm." is a permanent and standing subcommittee of the Board. The Ex. Comm. shall consist of the Current Officers and the previous president. All members have a committee vote. Actions require a quorum of three (3) and a majority vote of these present. Voting by e-mail is permitted.

Current executive board members include the following positions

- Club President officer
- Vice President officer
- Secretary officer
- Treasurer officer
- Past President

Proposed changes to the language in the constitution:

Article IV Government Section B-1 (Members)

The Ex. Comm. Is a permanent and standing committee of the club consisting of the current officers and the trip committee chair

Article II DEFINITIONS AND CONVENTIONS

Section F: Executive Committee

The "Executive Committee" hereinafter referred to as the "Ex. Comm." is a permanent and standing sub-committee of the Board. The Ex. Comm. shall consist of the Current Officers and the trip committee chair. All members have a committee vote. Actions require a quorum of three (3) and a majority vote of these present. Voting by e-mail is permitted, previous president.

This proposed change would remove **past president** from the executive committee and replace with the **trip committee chair.**
