View from the Top– Jason S.

Happy December Skiers and Riders,

As we have been teased by a very short-lived spattering of snow, and some cold temperatures, here in the Midwest we wait patiently for our first substantial snowfall or at least cold enough temperatures to support snow making at our local resorts. It's always exciting to see "the race to open" at the Western and Eastern resorts with runs and resorts opening almost daily now. I am excited for this season, getting back out on the snow to see all my ski and boarding friends and coworkers.

If you are holding onto those Certificates and ski vouchers, get them in and get on a trip. Those certificates do have an expiration date, and while we have waived those in the past due to the pandemic and other unforeseen circumstances, we must move forward. So, if you have certificates this is your last chance to use them, going forward next season we will no longer be accepting certificates earned as door prizes or compensation for leading activities and or club functions past their expiration date. Please use up those older vouchers as we need to clean up the books for our treasurer.

As a well-seasoned and experienced ski club full of well-seasoned skiers and riders, it's only a matter of time that we will experience bumps and bruises that we USE TO recover quickly from. Having taken my first sled ride down the hill with ski patrol at the reigns last season I can honestly tell you that it is not a fun experience at all, while all the attention I received at the ski patrol hut from patrollers and resort management was nice. It's an experience I do not wish to repeat. So, a few tips from a experienced or seasoned skier and rider. First, stretch! Remember back to our days in gym class where we first learned to stretch our body, bend over and touch those toes go slow and allow those muscles stretch...yes, you'll feel it hold it for a few seconds. Spread those legs and stretch side to side, reach down to each foot while legs are spread wider than your shoulders, use both hands to reach down twisting slightly at the waist. While your legs are spread try to reach down with both hands to the middle and place your palms down on the ground. Dress for warmth and protection, impact shorts typically worn by park skiers and riders will also help protect hips and tail bone from bumps and bruises and provide an extra layer of warmth from cold lift chairs. Helmets! As a generation X'r, I would never have believed that I would wear a helmet for biking and skiing, but not only does it provide protection from falls and errant chair lifts smacking into the back of your head, they provide rain and cold protection as well. Learn to fall.... It's only a matter of time until you fall, if you know you're going to fall rather than trying to brace or stop the fall, go with it keep those arms tucked close to the body and roll to expend the energy of the impact of the fall. Keep those legs up off the snow and downhill from your body. If on a steep hill where you are sliding and can't seem to stop, roll onto your belly and use your hands and top of the pole grip as an anchor and slowly use ski or board edge as an anchor into the snow to slow and stop your slide. Don't forget to laugh! When I do fall rather than dropping a "OH (insert expletive)" I like to laugh or giggle, keeps me loose and keeps from tensing up. A rigid object will break, a flexible object will bend....

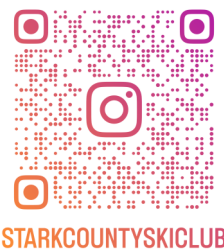
