

We will be chauffeured in a beautiful motor coach. We will be visiting five of the best wineries in Ohio. We will spend the night in the region's premier accommodations at the Lodge at Geneva-On-The-Lake. So many great things are happening at Ohio's most fun ski resort! The owners are putting their money where their mouth is and re -investing in the resort once again in the off season.

One big upgrade is a bunch of new snowmakers, and new water lines to them. They are also looking at the installation of a rope tow to West Woods park to take some congestion off of the West Woods lift. Season passes are available for 20% off the regular rate. Saturday, January 11th is SCSC's family fun day at Snow Trails. I plan on giving away 2 day passes at the December meeting. Get up on your Snow Trails history, and maybe you can win! The format will be the same as last year. Meeting in Valley Lodge, bring a dish to share. I'll be there all day.

We still have one opening for the Mammoth trip. We will continue to take applications and add people to a standby list in the order in which applications are received. Thanks to our friends at United Airlines, our flights out to Mammoth have changed. We will fly into Reno instead of Bishop. The return flight has not changed. Due to this change, the trip cost will go up about \$40. Please see the trip flyer in this newsletter for further details.

We still have openings for Whiteface/Gore. This is a good trip for skiers and riders as well as those who don't ski. Lake Placid has hosted two Winter Olympics. There is an Olympic Village, a museum, bobsledding, tobogganing, and other fun diversions off-mountain. See the trip flyer in this newsletter for additional details. We still have openings for the Holiday Valley / Kissing Bridge trip. The format is essentially same as H&H trips in the past. The main difference is that we will ski at Kissing Bridge on Thursday instead of Holimont. Kissing Bridge has expanded their snow-making capacity this year to provide more skiable terrain regardless of the whims of Mother Nature. We have scheduled the trip one week later than in the past to allow more time for natural snow. Please refer to the trip flyer in this newsletter for additional details. Included in this newsletter is a flyer for a weekend ski trip to the Poconos. We will be staying at Camelback Mountain. The trip starts March 8, 2025. The base price of the trip includes two nights of lodging. There is an option to add a third night for an additional charge. Admission to an indoor water park is included in the price of the trip. You may choose to ski at Camelback or nearby Blue Mountain. Lift tickets for either resort may be purchased at our group discount price. Camelback and Blue Mountain are both IKON resorts. This is a great location for family fun.

We are putting together a trip to an all-inclusive resort in the Dominican Republic. The target date for this trip is October 2025. At this time, we are planning to book two 7-bedroom villas, which will provide capacity for 28 participants. Each villa has its own pool and a common area with a full kitchen. Each bedroom has its own bathroom. Additional details will be provided after we can get airline pricing this month.

We have already booked our 2026 Western ski trip. We will be going to Heavenly, an EPIC, March 21-28, 2026. We will be staying at the Forest Suites condos, which are located directly across from the gondola. We are booking trips early in order to secure the best accommodations at the lowest price.






## 2024-2025 Seasonal Club Passes
