At long last, ski and boarding season is here and we have a full slate of trips to look forward to! Details for all of our trips may be found in the trip flyers included in this newsletter.

First up is our Snow Trails Family Fun Day. We will be meeting in the Valley Lodge January 11 at 9:00 AM. Please bring a dish to share. There are outlets available for crock pots. DAY PASSES MUST BE PURCHASED IN ADVANCE ON LINE. THERE ARE NO WALK-UP LIFT TICKET SALES.

Next up is the Holiday Valley / Kissing Bridge bus trip January 15-17. We will be loading the bus at the Metallus (formerly Timken) parking lot on Faircrest Avenue at 2:30PM and departing promptly at 3:00PM. Snowmaking capacity at Kissing Bridge was substantially expanded over the summer.

Our Eastern ski trip is to one of the most iconic resorts in the U. S.: Whiteface Mountain at Lake Placid. Lake Placid has hosted two Winter Olympics in 1932 and 1980. The 1980 Olympic Games was the site of "The Miracle on Ice", where the U.S. hockey team beat the formidable Russian squad and eventually won the gold medal. The Olympic Village has many interesting diversions off of the slopes.

Our Western trip is to Mammoth Mountain. Mammoth is known for reliable snow and one of the longest ski seasons in the country.

We'll close out the season with a weekend trip to Camelback Mountain in Pennsylvania. Admission to an indoor water park is included. Snow tubing is available for an additional charge that you pay at the resort. Camelback is an IKON resort so, WE ENCOURAGE ANYONE WITH AN IKON PASS TO JOIN US!

The trips to Lake Placid and Camelback are self drive. Get together with your friends to share the ride. If you are interested in carpooling, contact the trip leader and we will try to connect those who want to ride with those who are looking for riders.

We are planning a trip to an all-inclusive resort in the Dominican Republic October 19-25, 2025. Flights need to be confirmed in order to finalize the schedule and the cost. A flyer for this trip may be found in this newsletter. We will stay at Lifestyles Holiday Resorts in Puerto Plata. We have reserved two 7-bedroom villas. Each villa can accommodate up to 14 people. Each bedroom has its own bathroom. All rooms have a single king size bed. Each villa has its own pool. Trip cost is expected to be \$1,900 per person for double occupancy or \$2,050 for a single occupant. Air transportation, ground transfers from/to the airport in the DR, lodging, meals, and beverages are included. Again, FLIGHTS MUST BE CONFIRMED TO FINALIZE THE SCHEDULE AND THE PRICE. A VALID PASSPORT WILL BE REQUIRED. Once all trip details have been finalized, an email will be sent to all club members with a link to the trip application.



2025 SCSC Parking






