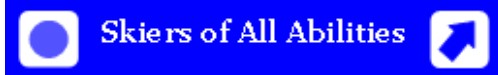

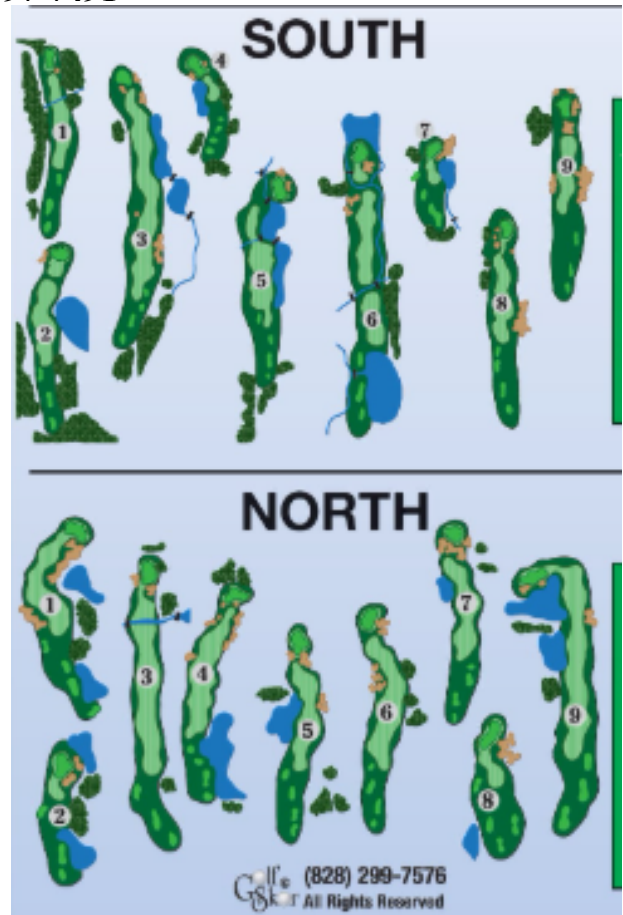

A word from the Trip Committee- Denise L.

Spring is here and although the ski season is over the trip committee will be meeting to finish up plans for our 26/27 ski season and to plan our western trip for 2028. Please keep watch for announcements with all the trip details in the upcoming newsletters.

For those who missed the meeting, I just returned from Whistler, Canada where I attended the Mountain Travel Symposium. I arrived a little late due to plenty of flight issues, but I still was able to meet several trip chairs, trip leaders, and club presidents from various ski clubs in our area and across the country. I met one on one with 30 vendors who provided information on their resorts and why we should come visit. I also attended presentations by representatives of Anchorage Alaska, the Trentino region of Italy, HX Expeditions and IKON to name a few. After all of this, I think I have added at least 25 places to my bucket list and hopefully a few places that will interest our club members.

Last month we started taking applications and deposits on our trip next year to Banff, Canada. Make sure your passports are ready. The trip is scheduled for March 20-27, 2027. Nine applications have been received for this trip so far and I hear there are more interested. The trip flyer is included with this month's newsletter and has all the details. Travel & Leisure has named this ski resort as the No. 1 in North America for 25/26 by users of On the Snow. There are 3 Peaks (Banff Sunshine, Lake Louise, and Mt. Norquay) and more than 3,500 feet of vertical. It has a long ski season which often runs from early November to late May. Ken Hutter will be leading the trip. He said some are considering a day trip to Kissing Horse. This is an Ikon resort, but multi-day ski lift tickets are also an option. Here is the pricing:

Drew Gonyias is working on ironing out the details for our annual Holiday Valley Trip. Keep a lookout for information to come on this trip in late Spring or early summer.

We are also working on plans for an East Coast trip to Killington, Vermont (February 21–26, 2027).

We've received two proposals, and the trip committee will review them and select the best option for our club. Lift tickets are included in the proposal price. Members with an IKON Pass will receive a discount on the trip price.

Multi-day lift tickets are available for both trips. However, if you're attending both trips—or planning additional visits to an IKON resort—an IKON Pass may be the better option. Here is the link to purchase an IKON Pass at the group rate.
