Dear Members,

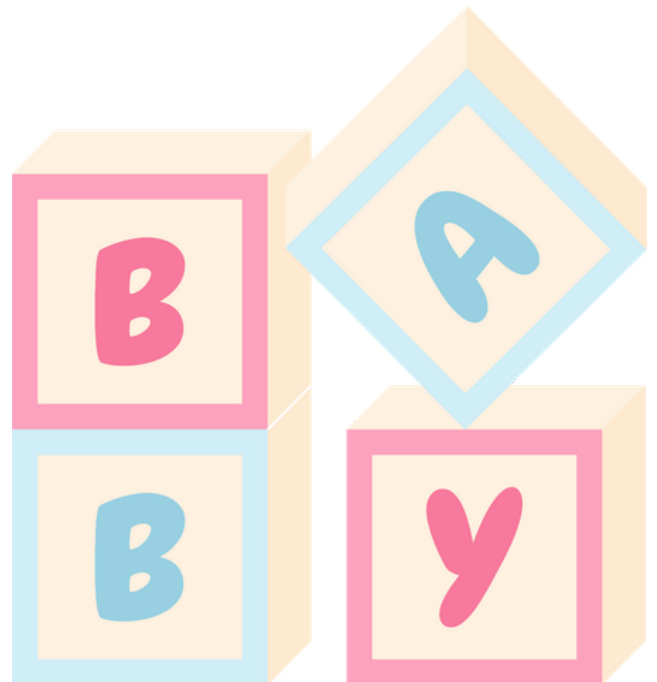

A word from the Trip Committee- Denise L.

This year is flying by for me. Maybe partly because I have done quite a bit of traveling on our club trips. I have enjoyed them all...Holiday Valley/Kissing Bridge, Okemo, Tahoe, Whistler (despite flight issues and limited time), Alaska, and a day at Mohican. Matt has shared a wonderful update on our Alaska cruise. It has been great getting to know more members of our club and sharing fun times and memories.

The trip committee and other members of our club have been working hard so that we can offer some great travel opportunities for our upcoming 2026/2027 season. This newsletter includes the flyers with trip application links for all we have planned. Look for the flyers for the two new trips that are being announced this month.

I will be sharing the previously announced trips with the Cleveland Metro Ski Council to post on the website in hopes that we can fill them. If you are interested, please submit your trip applications, as soon as possible. Our first trip for the 2026/2027 season just added is a one-day wine trip on October 3, 2026. Gail has arranged and will lead a fun-packed day visiting four locations in Southeast Ohio via an LED motorcoach. A wine-tasting at one of the wineries is included. Members may invite friends and family who are not members of the club. The price is \$50 per person. Let's fill this 55-passenger bus up!

Our next trip, January 13-15, 2027 will be our yearly visit to Ellicottville, New York. It is a little bit different this year. We will be skiing both days at Holiday Valley. The cost this year is \$425 which includes travel via an LED motorcoach, 2 nights lodging at the Wingate by Wyndham hotel in Ellicottville and 2 days of lift tickets. Drew Gonyias will lead the trip and he is taking applications and payment now.

Our east coast trip is to Killington, Vermont. The trip is scheduled for February 21-27, 2027. Note it is not by bus as originally thought but by train and we will be staying at the Killington Grand Resort with ski in/ski out access. We will travel via Amtrak from Cleveland to Albany, NY and then catch a motorcoach bus up to our lodging. The price for a double is \$1,709 with pricing options also for singles, triples, or quads. The price includes 4 days of lift tickets. There is a \$260 discount off the price for IKON Pass holders and non-skiers. I will be leading this trip. Please check the flyer for further details and the application link.

A family fun weekend trip at Camelback Mountain has been added for March 5-7, 2027. Camelback Ski Resort (an IKON resort) located in Tannersville, PA boasts the most skiable terrain in the Poconos and one of the biggest snow tubing parks in the United States. It also offers an indoor water park (Aquatopia). There is something to do for all. Lodging for two nights in Double-Queen Suites (max 4 occupants) including access to the indoor waterpark is available at a cost of \$680 per room. We have a contract for ten rooms. Discount pricing is also available for lift tickets, ski rentals and snow tubing provided we meet a minimum. There are also options for food vouchers for breakfast and meals at an additional cost. John Masalko and Jason Stephan will co-lead this trip. This resort is also on the IKON pass.

Last but far from least is our Banff, Canada trip scheduled for March 20-27, 2027. Banff is situated within Banff National Park, the third oldest national park in the world, established in 1885. It is renowned for its breathtaking landscapes, including mountains, lakes, and wildlife. In my opinion, it sounds like a trip I don't want to miss and a place I can't wait to see. The trip is priced at \$2,030 per person for a double occupancy. The price includes airfare, lodging, and breakfast. Check your passport and sign up. If you don't have a passport, you have plenty of time to get one. Here is the website to get you started <https://www.usa.gov/passport>. Skiing is available at three locations – Sunshine, Lake Louise, & Norquay. Ken Hutter will be leading. He is planning an optional side trip to Kicking Horse for anyone interested. I am sure he will have some wonderful places in mind for dining. The Banff ski locations are on the IKON pass but we also have pricing for lift tickets for those not holding a pass as follows:

Trip Recap- Alaska Cruise, Matt S.

In June, 25 of us took an amazing trip to Alaska. We spent 7 days on a Princess cruise ship and 3 days on a land tour. Most of us took an early morning flight from Cleveland to Vancouver via Detroit I must admit that I was a little concerned that we flew the same day that we boarded the ship but, the flights were uneventful and we arrived in Vancouver right on time. Navigating through customs in Vancouver was easy and once we picked up our luggage from baggage claim we were met by representatives of Princess for a smooth transfer from the airport to the ship. The embarkation process at the cruise terminal was efficient and we were on board the ship hours before departure. We were able to enjoy a welcome beverage and lunch, go through a simple safety/muster process, and get to our cabins to settle in for the adventures that awaited us.

Our ship, the Discovery Princess, one of the newer vessels in the Princess fleet, was amazing. There was an incredible variety of entertainment and activities available from morning to late into the evening. There were Broadway and Vegas style shows in the main theater, comedians, game shows, and informational programs in a couple of smaller venues. There was always some type of musical entertainment available in the Piazza, the beating heart of the ship, and the many lounges scattered around our home on the water. There was a casino, a spa where you could enjoy a relaxing massage, and many options for food ranging from burger and pizza stands, buffets, the main dining rooms, and a couple of fine dining options. The entire Princess crew was very friendly and helpful. The cabins were clean and comfortable.

The cruise included stops at Ketchikan, Juneau, Skagway, Glacier Bay, and College Fjord. At each port, we had the option to stay on board to enjoy the ship's accommodations, take an excursion, or just walk around to enjoy the local shops and restaurants. The Alaskan fare included locally caught salmon, halibut, and crab. Some of the excursions we enjoyed included whale watching, helicopter tours with glacier landings, dog sled camps, nature hikes, and a scenic rail journey to the Yukon. Some members of our group went golfing at 10:00 PM in The Land of the Midnight Sun. From our decks and on land we were able to see stunning Alaskan scenery and a variety of wildlife including moose, sea otters, seals and sea lions, reindeer, bears, bald eagles, humpback whales, and orcas. At College Fjord, we were able to experience up close views and sounds of glaciers calving.

Our final cruise stop was Whittier, a port near Anchorage. From Whittier, we took a 10-hour rail journey to the Denali Princess wilderness lodge. Accommodations on the train were very nice. We had comfortable seats on a 2nd floor observation car where we were able to enjoy the phenomenal Alaska scenery. We had beverage service on the observation deck. We also had a dining area on the lower level of our car where we could eat and share tables for games and conversation. The onboard staff were very accommodating. The lodge was very nice. We had a very informative wildlife viewing tour. From Denali Princess Lodge, we travelled to McKinley Princess Lodge. There, we saw a treehouse that was constructed by the Treehouse Masters. From there, we travelled to Anchorage for our final evening in Alaska before returning home. Most of us gathered that evening for a last meal together and drinks before taking in some of the sites in Anchorage.

Princess logistics were exceptional. The weather was generally good with daytime highs in the 60's and very little rain. Unfortunately, the weather was not clear enough to be able to see the peak of Mt. Denali. What really made the trip special were all of the times that we were able to share with a great group of very special people. We took full advantage of GroupMe to communicate important information, make plans to meet, and to share experiences and photos. This truly was an incredible journey that, I think, we all enjoyed!
